Appropriate vs. Inappropriate

1. Dresses may not be cut below the bust line.



2. Dresses may be backless as long as they are not cut below the naval.



Appropriate vs. Inappropriate

3. Midriffs will not be exposed. (This includes both front and side.)



#4 Dresses may not have a slit that exceeds mid-thigh and skirts must reach fully extended finger tip length.
